Medication Management Training for PERSONAL CARERS

course aim

To assist Carers in the safe delivery of medications by providing:

- * Awareness of legal responsibilities;
- * Information on the role & responsibilities when administering medications;
- * Understanding of policy and procedure requirements;
- * Instruction for safe use of pre-packed & non-packed medications according to policy and procedures;
- * An understanding of residents' rights
- * Understanding the Carer's role in an organisation and reporting of medication incidences.

who should attend

This workshop is suited to experienced Carers whose duties may involve the distribution of Medications to their residents.

why attend

The administration of medications is a complex issue with enormous potential for harm. This workshop will provide Carers with an awareness of the principles underlying distribution of Medications and the practical skills to safely perform the task. A certificate of safe practice will be issued, valid for twelve months.

contents

Legal considerations - Administration guidelines and systems - Medication errors and what to do - Medication charts and documentation - What is safe practice?

practical component

All participants will need to arrange with their employer two supervised medication rounds. Alternatively, an Atlantic assessor can supervise you at your place of employment (charges on request).

materials

The course cost includes a workbook for the participant that they can use to refer back to the course content, and an assessment of clinical practice booklet to show evidence of clinical assessment.
